11	OBJECTING TO THE LOCATION OF A MODERN PIT FACILITY IN NORTHERN
12	NEW MEXICO AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO INFORM FEDERAL
13	AUTHORITIES OF THE OBJECTIONS.

15	WHEREAS, the United States department of energy has announced support for a plan to
16	build a modern pit facility to produce plutonium pits in New Mexico; and
17	WHEREAS, plutonium pits are used to trigger nuclear weapons; and
18	WHEREAS, the use of plutonium creates health and environmental hazards; and
19	WHEREAS, the governing body of the city of Santa Fe does not support the creation of
20	further health and environmental hazards related to nuclear weapons for the citizens of northern
21	New Mexico; and
22	WHEREAS, the United States house energy and water appropriations committee has
23	recently found the construction of the modern pit facility to be "premature"; and
24	WHEREAS, it is the declared policy of the United States government to help constrain

the global proliferation of weapons of mass destruction.

1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
2	CITY OF SANTA FE that the governing body hereby states its objection to the department of
3	energy regarding the location of a new and or expanded modern pit facility in northern New
4	Mexico; and
5	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that given the lack of discovered aging effects
6	impacting plutonium pit safety and reliability, the lack of need for high production rates given the
7	recently ratified treaty with Russia requiring massive future arms reductions, and the need for the
8	United States to show global leadership by example in constraining the production and spread of
9	weapons of mass destruction, the governing body objects to the construction and operation of the
10	modern pit facility anywhere; and
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the governing body directs the city clerk to send
12	copies of this resolution to our congressional delegation, our governor, the department of energy,
13	and the national nuclear security administration.
